My aesthetic is made up of the world that has nurtured me: the roaring city, the aroma of arroz con guandules and jerk chicken, the fabrics of family drama, the silenced cries of neighborhood tragedies, the vibrant colors of adolescent curiosity, the soft ballads of first love, and the resilient terrains of poverty. I write political, philosophical, and character-driven plays that explore what it means to *exist*, focusing on human wounds and needs, the role of matriarchy, the Afro-Diaspora culture, and the systems in which we live.
